UPDATED: Coronavirus Response Protocol

	Mask	Test	Other Precautions
If Exposed	10 days	● After Day 5	Do not go places where you are unable to wear a mask, including travel and public transportation settings.
If Test Positive	Mask	Isolation ends	Other Precautions
Test Positive w/o Symptoms	10 days	After Day 5	 Wear mask for 10 days Do not travel and avoid public transportation, ride-sharing, or taxis if possible.
Test positive w/Symptoms		 After Day 5 if fever-free (w/o medication) for 24 hours and your symptoms are improving Test Negative 	
NOTE: Mask should be a "Good Quality" mask or Respirator (ex: N95)			
NOTE: ISOLATION Day 1 is the first full day after known exposure, your symptoms developed or your test specimen (that tested positive) was collected.			
NOTE: If your COVID-19 symptoms recur or worsen, restart your isolation at day 0
